

YOUTH CAMP: June 17-20 or July 29-August 1

Cost Per Camper: \$150 Ages: 8-14 years old

Check In: Edor Nelson Field, 8:30-9 a.m.

Time: 9:30 a.m.-Noon each day

Includes: Individual position instructions for both offense and defense. The camp will also include motivational sessions by coaches and players during breaks. This is a non-padded, non-contact camp.

MIDDLE SCHOOL CAMP: August 5-9 "Week with the Auggies"

Cost Per Camper: \$360

Grades: 6-9

Check In: Kennedy Center, 8:30 a.m.

Early Drop off: 8 a.m. (\$50 extra per camper) **Late pick up:** 6 p.m. (\$50 extra per camper)

Includes: Lunch at the cafeteria will be provided each day. Participants will receive instruction on both offense and defense. They will also learn basic fundamentals of the game of football by engaging in flag football games. Participants may have the choice to watch Auggie football film or play dodgeball, kickball, or other various activities. This is a non-padded, non-contact camp.

HIGH SCHOOL CAMP: July 29-August 2 "Elite Camp"

Cost per camper: \$180

Grades: 9-12

Check In: Kennedy Center, 5:30 p.m.

Times: 6-9 p.m.

Includes: Individual sessions with both offense and defense. OL/DL one-on-ones, SKILL 7-on-7, and strength and conditioning testing administered by Augsburg coaches. This is a padded and contact camp. Participants will need to provide

their own gear.
